

Chapter 3: “THE WRATH OF GOD IS REVEALED FROM HEAVEN”

1. Be able to explain “from heaven,” and “from earth.” Neither is not necessarily a “place.” If not, then identify, explain, and discuss what is “heaven” and what is “earth.”
2. After understanding “from heaven,” how is “the wrath of God” revealed from “heaven”? (see pp. 23-24).
3. God judges us in righteousness (his heavenly principles). Satan judges us through “iniquity” (his good and evil principle, the earthly principle). Pinpoint and discuss the extreme differences between God’s principles and Satan’s principles.
4. It is because of God’s loving protection that we are not consumed by the destroyer. In light of this, how important is it that we can chose correctly the best jurisdiction? (see 1 Peter 5:8, Lam. 3: 22-23, and also refer to pp. 32-38).
5. What makes God’s judgment fair and Satan’s unfair?
